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1. Purpose

2. Policy Statement

Protection of the environment is an integral part of Swire Bulk's business philosophy and Swire Bulk will aim to ensure that its business practices minimise, or eliminate where possible, detrimental effects on the environment.

Swire Bulk's staff, both at sea and ashore, will carry out their work giving environmental concerns the highest priority possible and, by doing so, aspire to be "best in class" concerning all related environmental matters.

In our operations and the locations in which we operate, we will:

- Aim to constantly strive to reduce the negative impacts that our business has on the environment and to monitor performance and identify areas for improvement;

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5. Policy Details

5.1 Improving environmental performance

Swire Bulk will improve corporate practices and environmental performance, taking account of current legislation, industry codes of practice, technical developments, consumer needs and community expectations.

Swire Bulk will take voluntary steps, where possible and appropriate, to improve current environmental performance.

Swire Bulk will measure environmental performance, conduct regular environmental audits, assess legal requirements and these principles, publishing relevant information, internally and externally as appropriate.

5.2 Employee Training

Swire Bulk will educate, train and motivate employees to conduct activities in an environmentally responsible manner.

5.3 Management of Waste

Swire Bulk will assess, design and operate ships considering the efficient use of energy and materials, to minimise adverse environmental impacts and waste generations.

Swire Bulk will dispose of residual waste materials safely, responsibly and sustainably.

5.4 Environmental regulations and issues

Swire Bulk will conduct or support research, where appropriate, on environmental issues associated with vessels' activities.

Swire Bulk will develop, maintain and improve emergency preparedness plans in conjunction with emergency services, relevant authorities and the community consistent with current legislation and good practice.

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Swire Bulk will meet or exceed all legal requirements.

5.5 Working with stakeholders

Swire Bulk will promote adoption of these principles by the Company’s suppliers and contractors encouraging and, where appropriate, requiring improvements in their practices to make them consistent with those of the Company.

Swire Bulk will promote good public relations and foster open dialogue with employees, relevant authorities and the public, anticipating and responding to concerns about potential environmental hazards and impact of company operations.

6. Governance

6.1 Policy Owner

6.2 Failure to Comply

Employees must adhere to the conditions of this policy at all times. Non-compliance must be communicated to the policy owner immediately.

From time to time instances arise where exceptions to this policy may be required. Any exception requests must be submitted to the policy owner for consideration and approval.

6.4 Changes to Policy

Swire Bulk reserves the right to amend this policy at its sole discretion. In case of amendments, the policy owner will inform staff appropriately.
